PLEASE ARRIVE ONE HOUR BEFORE YOUR START TIME.

REGISTRATION - 9TH AUGUST 2025

Registration is the morning of the event. Registration is in the <u>Killary Adventure Centre</u> past reception in the sun room. **Registration opens from 9:00am.**

Please know your RACE NUMBER and wave BEFORE coming to registration.

EVENT SHIRT - you can collect this at registration when you collect your race number.

HIRED WETSUITS

Hired wetsuits to be collected in the Killary Adventure Centre. We will do our best to match your requested sizes but cannot guarantee an exact match.

A deposit of 20.00 Euro in cash only is required for the hired wetsuits. Please have this with you when collecting.

START LINE AND START TIME

You chose your wave when you registered online. Please note there are **four start times.**

Wave 1 + 2 - 10:30am

Wave 3 + 4 - 10:45am

Wave 5 + 6 - 11:00am

Wave 7 + 8 - 11:15am

Be there 10 mins before your start time for your safety briefing and warm-up outside the Killary Adventure Centre!

Cut off Time: 3:00pm

WHAT TO WEAR

We strongly recommend you wear a wetsuit or at the very least full body cover. **Shorts and t-shirts are a complete no-no.** We also recommend gloves for the cold and the rope elements. Finally, it is a good idea to tape your shoes to you so as not to lose them in the mud.

PLEASE NOTE you will be climbing through, under and over trees, fallen trees, climbing ropes, jumping off obstacles and much more so you may receive cuts, bruises and grazes. This is the only path to becoming a Warrior

CHANGING FACILITIES:

FEMALE - AT THE BACK OF THE CENTRE BESIDE SUN ROOM

MALE - IN THE GREEN DOME BEHIND THE CENTRE.

There is limited space in the changing area, so if you can, please change at your car.

We DO NOT HAVE SHOWERING FACILITIES

available on site. All of our water is heated using a Biomass Boiler which doesn't have the capacity for so many showers.

CHANGE OF CLOTHES: Ensure you bring a change of clothes to put on after the event as you will be wet and cold

THE COURSE

Swimmer/Non Swimmer | We have a number of obstacles that involve entering water. At each of these obstacles we will have a wading option of forfeit for those who cannot swim.

MARSHALS

We will have marshals at obstacles along the way. These marshals are there for your safety, not to help you complete the challenges. Competitors will need help from other competitors to complete some obstacles. Remember Warriors, you are all in this together

VALUABLES

We advise you to leave valuables at home. Car keys can be dropped in the Killary Adventure Centre near registration. Please bring an envelope to put your car keys in. Please write your name, your wrist band number and your car registration on the envelope. You can pick up your key after the race at the entrance of the Sun Room (next to the main reception).

Killary Adventure Co will not be responsible for valuables left in changing facilities.

SPECTATORS

Check our obstacle course map <u>here</u> and remember you must park at Killary Adventure Centre and walk to these locations, **cars are NOT allowed on the course.**

FINISH LINE LOCATION

The finish line will be located at the front of the <u>Killary</u> <u>Adventure Centre</u>

FACILITIES AT THE FINISH LINE

Please change into your change of clothes at your car or in the changing facilities provided at the back of the Centre. There is limited space in the changing area, please change at your car if you can.

WARRIOR SUSTENANCE

After changing into warm clean clothes, please make your way upstairs into the Killary Adventure Centre. There is hot food, hot whiskey and refreshments.

Entry is still <u>open online</u> until 2pm on Thursday, the 7th of August. Entry will also be possible on the day at registration from 9.00am - 11.00am and will cost 100.00 Euro.
